to November 1930 Ford used a round split rubber grommet. After September 1930 the grommet was inside a metal cover attached with three rivets. The rivets and cover were painted the firewall color.

From mid-1928 through 1929 the date of manufacture was stamped into the firewall on the left side on most vehicles. The numbers may have been stamped upside down.

ENGINE (Left side)

The color of Ford engine green was neither bright nor dark. It did, however, vary in shade from engine to engine. All parts painted Ford engine green should match. The finish should have a rough textured appearance. The engine number should match the year and approximate month indicated for the vehicle. (Refer to the table of engine numbers). The assembly date for a vehicle may be as long as three months after the date the engine was produced. The style of numerals was changed in March 1931, altering the shapes of the 1, 6 and 9. The boss on the block for the number was painted with the engine and stamped afterwards. In the interest of preservation the stamped numerals may be painted engine green.

Model A cylinder heads had no pronounced numbers or letters on them. Some manufacturing marks may exist. Aftermarket heads will appear identical to the factory original heads, except they may have raised bosses with numbers or letters. Some service replacements were labeled "Ford USA" or "Ford." The letter "B" indicates
